## **Permissible Mobile Vendor Locations**

Where can I operate? Once you have acquired a Roving Vendor Permit and Park Endorsement Sticker for a given year, you may operate your food truck or cart in designated spots in the following parks:

Note that only one vendor may operate at each of these sites at a time unless indicated otherwise. Access will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Vendors may only operate in the spot designated by a MOA Parks and Recreation sign indicating a vendor space.

**Right of Way Spots.** There are other designated spots in Anchorage near MOA parks that are governed by the Right of Way Department. Your Park Endorsement Sticker <u>does not permit you</u> to operate in these spots, which include: Cuddy Family Midtown Park, Delaney Park Strip, Elderberry Park, Fairbanks Park, Fairview Park, Ocean View Park, Scenic Park, Wolverine Park and Wonder Park. If you would like to operate your cart in those spots, please contact the Streets/Right of Way Department for a permit.

What about other parks? Parks that do not appear on this list are either (a) not approved for roving park vendors at this time or (b) are already pre-assigned to vendors for a fee, whether by a bid process or other methods. Those pre-assigned locations include Town Square Park, Westchester Lagoon, Pena Park and Kincaid Park.
