Several commercial burglaries that appear to be related have taken place within the last 2 weeks in or near [redacted].

SERIES DESCRIPTION:

VICTIMS: Businesses in or near [redacted]

MO:

- Suspect prying door.
- Most often fleeing before entering business if an alarm is triggered
- When entering business, the suspect is targeting cash registers
- Most incidents happened on Tuesday or Saturday

SUSPECT INFORMATION:

- Only 1 incident contains suspect information indicating a [redacted] wearing a [redacted] backpack.

BURGLARY SERIES BULLETIN

Analyst is reviewing past 2 weeks burglary cases

Downloads cases listed as a burglary, vandalism and others - reads reports

As information from case is not in Tiburon yet, the analyst pulls information directly from Packetwriter reports and enters MO, person, suspect info into spreadsheet for analysis

- Also reviews photos and videos from cases to find additional information to add to series analysis

Searches for specific events which may be linked to the same suspects

As a burglary series is detected, further research is conducted to see if any other cases may be involved.

Information is passed to detectives and/or patrol, bulletins created to distribute information.

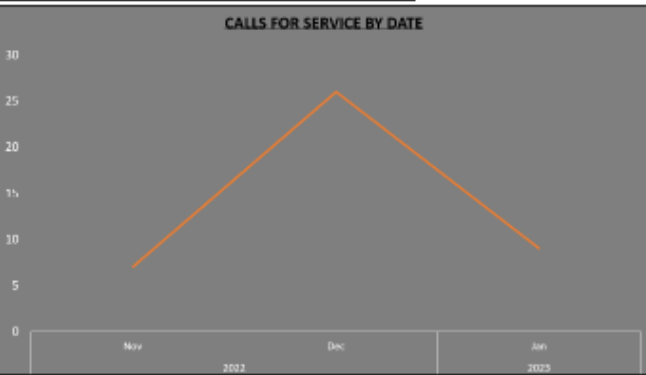

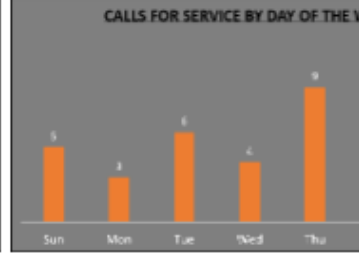

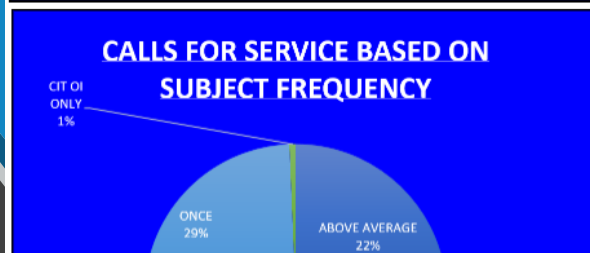

TOP 10 CALLS FOR SERVICE

CIT Dashboard

- Product originally intended to assist our CIT unit identify people most in need of assistance
- Requires complex formulas along with manual data entry do compliment the automated data pull
- Breaks down Mental/Suicidal individuals in need of assistance by shift, by time, day of week, what kind of calls and service they are using while comparing them to others in the same population group.
- Also looks at subjects by trend to see if they are escalating or de-escalating.

Warrant Packages

- Review warrant lists weekly/monthly
- Research which are most likely still in Alaska
- Conduct additional research through additional databases and open-source data to identify likely:
 - Addresses
 - Vehicles
 - Phone Numbers
 - Social Media Profiles
 - Most recent associates
 - Officer safety issues
- Create package for distribution to ISU and/or Patrol
