Public Safety Committee OEM Updates August 9, 2023

1. Response

- a. 6/29-7/11: University Lake Oil spill. Interagency Coordination (ANMC/MOA/DEC/F&G/EPA/USFW/etc.) and Public Information

2. Preparedness

- a. Planning
 - i. Public Outreach Focus: July-pet preparedness, August- children prepare
 - ii. MOA Emergency Operations Plan (EOP): On website. Formal distribution complete.
 - iii. Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP): Guidance update. Departments working on updates through 6 assignments. September 12 and 13 workshop will finish updates.
 - iv. Anchorage Local Emergency Planning Committee:
 1. 6/21 quarterly meeting: annual risk assessment and state funding recommendations
 2. 7/19 work session: drafting state funding recommendations. Including strategic planning, commodity study, administrative efficiencies.

3. Mitigation

- a. Outreach:
 - i. Upper Cook Inlet Tsunami Assessment Study. State DGGs release scheduled for 8/16.
 - ii. Language Access. Website complete. Extending to further outreach events and materials.
 - iii. Beetle Kill Removal w/Parks and AFD. Online mapping and trailside outreach are live. Will spread to Eagle River next year.
- b. Planning
 - i. CDBG-DR (2018 Earthquake) \$2.25M award pending for Neighborhood Plan Updates, Mitigation Planning, Seismic Risk Analysis. Appropriation in September.

4. Recovery

- a. Federal disasters
 - i. 2018 Earthquake: \$27,248,035.67 (68.02%)
 - ii. COVID-19: \$117,974,611.53 (97%). After-action and improvement plan resources obtained via CDC Health Equity Grant.
- b. State disasters
 - i. 2021 Southcentral Storm: \$505,736.21 (24.01%)
 - ii. 2022 Hiland Avalanche: \$870,708.07 (100%)
