The Administration submits this report pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code 3.102.010B.

Among other things, AMC 3.102.010B. requires the mayor or a designee to annually report by June 1, for each municipal department and agency that used an Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) in the preceding calendar year: (a) the number of instances in which a UAS was used; (b) a general description of the type and purpose of each use that sufficiently explains how the use was not prohibited, and (c) any new policy, or change in department or agency policy, related to the use of UAS.

22 23 The Port of Alaska contracted Upper One Studios during Spring 2018 to shoot a drone video of the 2016 completed stabilization work at the Ship Creek Boat Launch for comparison purposes to assist POA in determining if winter break-up damaged the armor rock structure in any way.

Solid Waste Services (SWS)

SWS had five occasions in 2018 where they contracted for a drone operator to survey the landfill:

CRW Engineering flew the landfill site on three instances in 2018: October 5, October 11, and October 14.

 CRW Engineering was tasked with surveying the landfill active-working face using a UAV. This work was confined to the active cell within the landfill property limits and was performed as a study to determine densities of waste tonnages to volume of airspace consumed.

FR Bell flew the landfill site on two instances in 2018: October 18 and October 26.

39 40 FR Bell & Associates performed UAV photographic mapping of the landfill as part of the department's annual aerial survey project. This project is confined to the landfill and is conducted to provide SWS with topographic survey and aerial imagery for future project planning and design purposes.

Parks and Recreation used drone services provided by TBC for Cheney Lake and Westchester Lagoon. Also, R&M did some work for Abbott-O-Rabbit little league (part of Ruth Arcand Park). The drone footage provided aerial imagery for laying out the winter maintained ice surfaces, prescribed areas for ice depth measurements, identifying the boundaries for safe skating, and use areas (speed skating oval, general ice skating, shinny hockey, and for Cheney Lake also noting the ice fishing area separate from the maintained skating area).

Municipal Light & Power (ML&P)

ML&P used a contractor, Alaska Aerial Media, in 2018 for Ortho-rectified Imagery Acquisitions for use of topographic survey, and engineering design purposes:
