





The Public Transportation Department will conduct public hearings on:

- 1. Proposed <u>People Mover</u> and <u>AnchorRIDES</u> changes to go into effect March 1, 2010; and
- 2. Proposed Public Transportation Department Program of Projects

Proposed People Mover and AnchorRIDES changes to go into effect March 1, 2010:

<u>People Mover</u> changes include: minor running time changes on specific routes; the elimination of Routes 76 and 77 and miscellaneous trip adjustments. Route #75 will begin service to the Veterans Administration Outpatient Clinic (opening in May 2010) located adjacent to Bartlett High School, across Muldoon Road from Tikahtnu Commons.

The proposed changes to People Mover bus routes will affect <u>AnchorRIDES</u> service areas and fares. AnchorRIDES Core service area includes locations within 3/4 mile of a People Mover route. Areas beyond 3/4 mile are considered "Premium" or out of service areas. Premium areas require higher fares and have different hours of service. The proposed changes to People Mover routes will change Eagle River from "Core" to "Premium". Representatives from AnchorRIDES will be available to discuss impacts of service changes to the AnchorRIDES service area.

The proposed Public Transportation Department Program of Projects, providing details on capital & operating projects funded by the Federal Transit Administration, will also be available for review and comment. The Municipality of Anchorage's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) process is used to satisfy the public participation process of the Program of Projects (POP) that is required in U.S.C. Section 5307. The POP as presented is the proposed Program of Projects and will also be the final Program of Projects unless amended.

Two (2) meetings are scheduled: Wednesday, January 20, 2010, 11:45 am to 1:15 pm and 4:45 pm to 6:15 pm at City Hall (632 W. 6th Avenue) in the Purchasing Conference Room 525.
