

Ordinance No. No. AO 2010-16, an ordinance of the Anchorage Municipal Assembly amending Anchorage Code Section 9.28.035, **Abatement of vehicles operat-**ed by delinquent offenders, to allow a new defense to vehicle impoundment, Assemblymember Ossiander.

Ordinance No. No. AO 2010-20, an ordinance of the Anchorage Assembly amending the zoning map and providing for the rezoning of the North 2.145 acres +/- of Lot 2A, Raspberry Subdivision, from R-O SL (Residential-Office District with Special Limitations) to B-1B SL (Community Business District with Special Limitations), and to repeal AO 2007-73 in its entirety as applied to the North Half of Lot 2A, Raspberry Subdivision; generally located one lot south of Raspberry Road, and on the west side of Northwood Street (Sand Lake Community Council) (Planning and Zoning Commission Case 2009-131).
