





The Assembly of the Municipality of Anchorage will hold a public hearing on the following resolution at its regular meeting of **December 15, 2009**. The public hearing portion of the meeting begins at 6:00 p.m. and is held in the Assembly Chambers, Z.J. Loussac Library, 3600 Denali:

Resolution No. AR 2009-287, a resolution of the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska, approving the Girdwood Water Improvements Phase II-B Transmission Main and providing for assessment of benefited properties at time of service connection, Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility.

GIRDWOOD WATER IMPROVEMENTS PHASE

AMC 19.90 and A.S. 42.05.385 require the Assembly's approval to construct a water main extension where the extension will create any charges or assessments against the adjacent properties. A public hearing is required prior to Assembly action.

The Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU) plans to construct a 16-inch water main to provide a looped water system on the west side of Glacier Creek and provide redundancy for the water distribution system in the New Girdwood Townsite. By doing so, water service will be available to five (5) parcels.

Initially, all costs to construct the proposed water main extension shall be borne by AWWU. When these newly benefited and previously un-assessed parcels connect to the water main, AWWU shall recover a pro-rated share of its costs through the Levy Upon Connection assessment procedures as authorized by the current Municipal Codes and Utility Tariff.

The properties benefiting from proposed construction, and subject to future assessments and charges, are identified on the proposed assessment roll, which is made part of the resolution carried by this memorandum. As each previously unassessed property seeks connection, the parcels' pro-rated share of assessable water main costs will be presented to the Assembly for confirmation of levy action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the AWWU Tariff in effect at the time of connection.

Owners of benefited property were notified of the estimated project cost, and their individual property's estimated cost allocation by certified mail on September 17, 2009. Property owners were invited to meet with AWWU at a time convenient for them for further information and discussion.

The passage of this resolution will have a fiscal impact on four (4) Municipal owned parcels: Alyeska – Prince Addition TR 1, Girdwood Elementary School TR A1A, Girdwood Elementary School TR B, T10N R2E SEC 9 S.M. TR 9A HLB 6-017

The AWWU Board reviewed and endorsed this resolution at its regular meeting of November 4, 2009
