

For FTA grant funds, applicants must meet eligibility criteria defined by the Federal Transit Administration which includes participation in the Human Services Transportation Planning process. To be eligible for funding, projects must be consistent with those priorities and strategies outlined in the 2009 Human Services Transportation Coordination Plan and must provide transportation service within the Municipality of Anchorage. Projects funded with AMHTA funds must meet FTA eligibility criteria and serve AMHTA targeted populations within the Municipality of Anchorage. JARC and New Freedom subrecipient grant awards will not exceed \$99,000. All applicants must complete the State of Alaska Public Transportation Management Survey.
