The procedure by which the public may speak to the Commission at its meeting is:

- 1. After the staff presentation is completed on public hearing items, the Chair will ask for public testimony on the issue.
- 2. Persons who wish to testify will follow the time limits established in the Commission Rules of Procedure.
 - a. Representatives of groups (community councils, PTA's etc.) 5 minutes.
 - b. Individuals 3 minutes.

3. When your testimony is complete, the Commission may ask you questions. You may only testify once on any issue unless questioned by the Commission.

NOTE: Persons planning to testify before the commission will be requested to identify themselves at the beginning of the hearing. Members of the public are asked to mute themselves except when they are testifying or answering questions from the Commission.

HHAND COMMISSION PURPOSE

Advise the mayor and the assembly on issues related o long-and short-term housing, homeless and ommunity development needs in the municipality, and strategies to effect revitalization of lower-neome and at-risk neighborhoods. The commission hall:

- . Review and make recommendations on the proposed allocation of all federal, state, and nunicipal revenues targeted for housing and community development programs managed by the nunicipality.
- d. Identify and address long-and short-term housing ssues in Anchorage, including strategies to stabilize and monitor the housing market, achieve a range of sousing options for sale and for rent and cost affective and socially responsible strategies to preserve or increase the supply of affordable housing.
- Advise the mayor and assembly as to policies, tractices and legislation which affect housing and ommunity development issues, neighborhood evitalization strategies, and progress related to plans and programs goals.
- Advise the planning and zoning commission about elevant housing and community development issues nd their connection with land use controls.
- 6. Participate in the development and implementation of the housing and community development consolidated that by providing information and policy advice about nunicipality's housing and community development needs and priorities.
- i. Advise the mayor and assembly as to the infrastructure, facilities, transportation, and public ervices needs of lower-income and at-risk neighborhoods.
- . Facilitate public participation in housing and neighborhood revitalization policies, plans, strategies, and programs.
- 3. Coordinate with the Anchorage Continuum of Care in the development and implementation of the Anchorage slan to address homelessness.
- Advise the mayor, and assembly on issues related to omelessness.
- O. Report to the mayor and assembly on the progress of the Anchorage plan to address comelessness. The report shall be presented on or before June 1 of each year and shall include recommendations for specific actions to implement the plan.
