In this Vote by Mail Election, qualified registered voters will be mailed a ballot package about three weeks before Election Day – this year on March 12, 2019.

Vote by Mail is as easy as 1 - 2 - 3!

- 1. Vote your ballot. Place your voted ballot into the security envelope and place the security envelope into your ballot return envelope.
- 2. Sign the voter declaration on the back of the ballot return envelope.
- 3. Return your ballot envelope.

There are three ways to return a ballot envelope:

- 1. Place your ballot return envelope in a Secure Drop Box; or
- 2. Take your ballot return envelope to an Accessible Vote Center; or
- 3. Mail your ballot return envelope with first class postage through USPS;
