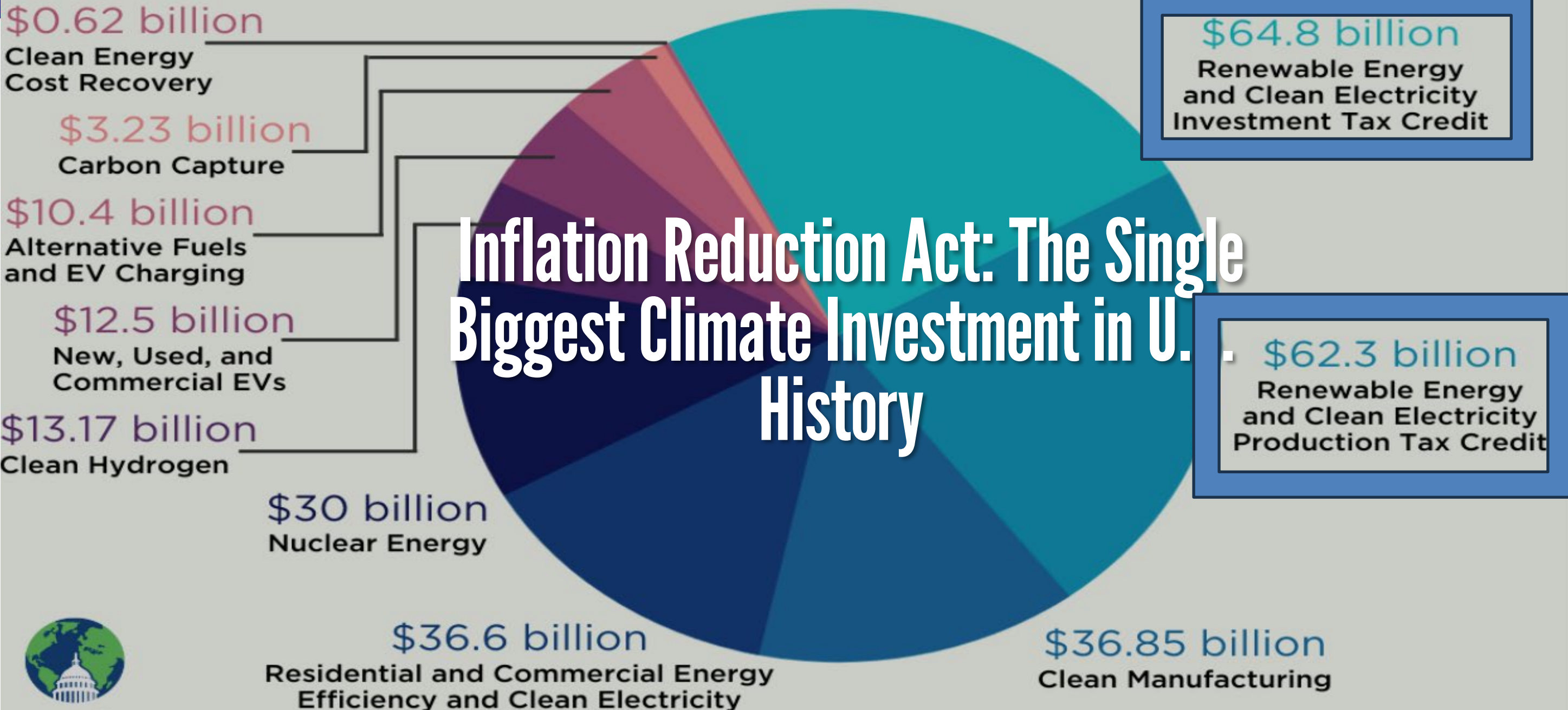

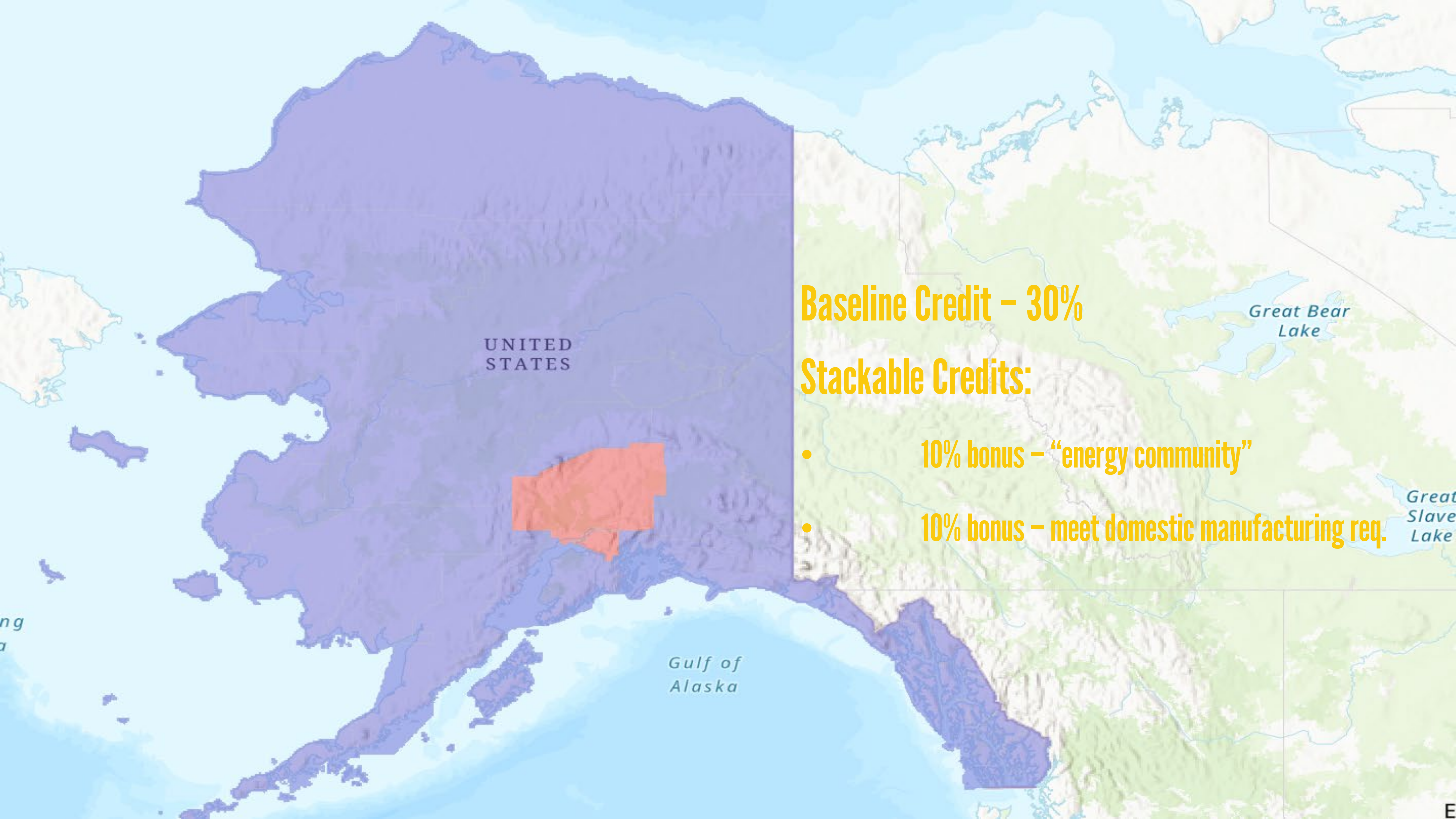

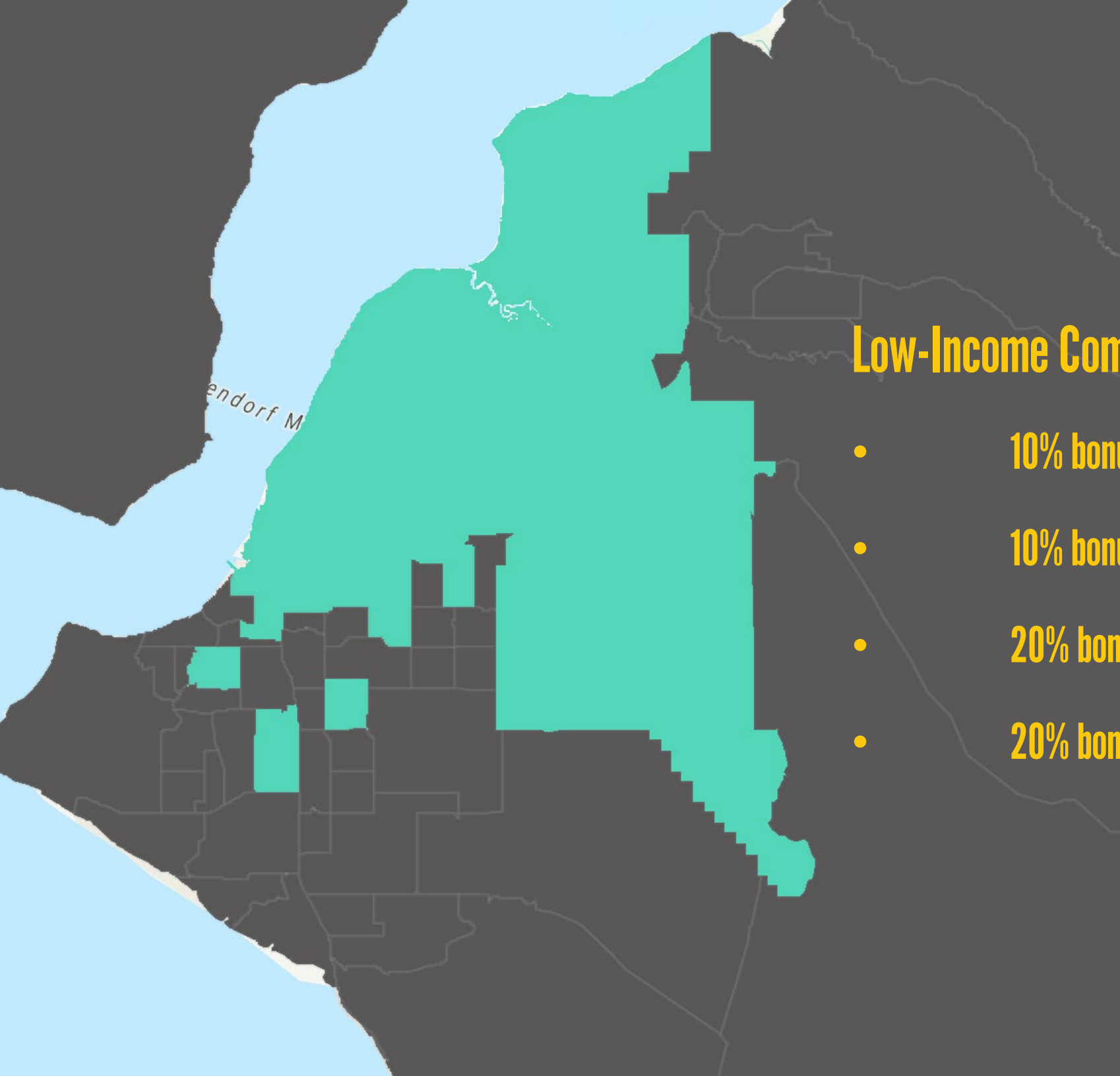

Baseline Credit – 30%

Stackable Credits:

- **10% bonus – “energy community”**
- **10% bonus – meet domestic manufacturing req.**



Low-Income Communities Bonus Credit (Pick one):

- 10% bonus – “located in low-income community”
- 10% bonus – “located on Tribal Land”
- 20% bonus – “qualified low-income residential project”
- 20% bonus – “qualified low-income economic benefit project”

- Adopted Policy of the Municipality of Anchorage
- Creates more opportunity for partnerships with tax-exempt organizations (non-profits, State of Alaska, Tribal governments, and Alaska Native Corporations.
- These credits are available yearly, through 2033.
