Accessible Vote Center (AVC) Services

- Return your mail ballot.
- Replace a lost or damaged ballot.
- Receive a ballot package if you did not receive one in the mail.
- Receive voting assistance.
- Access help for other voter questions.
- Register to vote.
- Vote a questioned or provisional ballot.

Voters in line at the AVCs by 8pm on Election Day will be allowed to vote or drop off their ballots.

May I Vote at an Accessible Vote Center (AVC)?

Yes, you may vote at an Accessible Vote Center (AVC) by:

- Dropping off your ballot return envelope containing your marked ballot.
- Taking your unmarked ballot package to an Accessible Vote Center (AVC) and marking your ballot in a voting booth.
- Requesting a replacement ballot to mark in a voting booth if you lose or do not receive your mailed ballot.
- Marked ballots are placed in a ballot return envelope and a secure ballot box for processing.
