Only voters living in Assembly District 3 may vote in the Special Election

How Do I Return My Ballot?

You may choose one of three methods for returning your ballot:

1. Place your ballot return envelope in a Secure Drop Box,
2. Take your ballot return envelope to the Accessible Vote Center (AVC), or
3. Mail your ballot return envelope with first class postage through the U.S. Post Office.

1. Return Your Ballot to a Secure Drop Box

Drop boxes will open 24/7 about 3 weeks before Election Day. Drop boxes will close at 8pm on Election Day, Tuesday, August 7, 2018.

Ballots must be returned to Drop Boxes no later than 8pm on Election Day.

Voters in line at the Drop Box locations by 8pm on Election Day will be allowed to drop off their ballots.

2. Return Your Ballot to an Accessible Vote Center (AVC)

The AVC will open July 10, 2018 at the MOA Election Center at 619 East Ship Creek Avenue at Door D.

Ballots must be returned to the AVC no later than 8pm on Election Day. Voters in line at the AVC by 8pm on Election Day will be allowed to vote or drop off their ballots.

3. Return Your Ballot by Mail

Using first class postage, mail your ballot return envelope through the U.S. Post Office, postmarked on or before Election Day, Tuesday, August 7, 2018.

Accessible Vote Center (AVC) Services

- Early voting available beginning July 10.
- Return your mail ballot.
- Vote in-person if you lose, damage, or do not receive your ballot package in the mail.
- Receive voting assistance.
- Access help for other voter questions.
- Register to vote.
- Vote a questioned or provisional ballot.

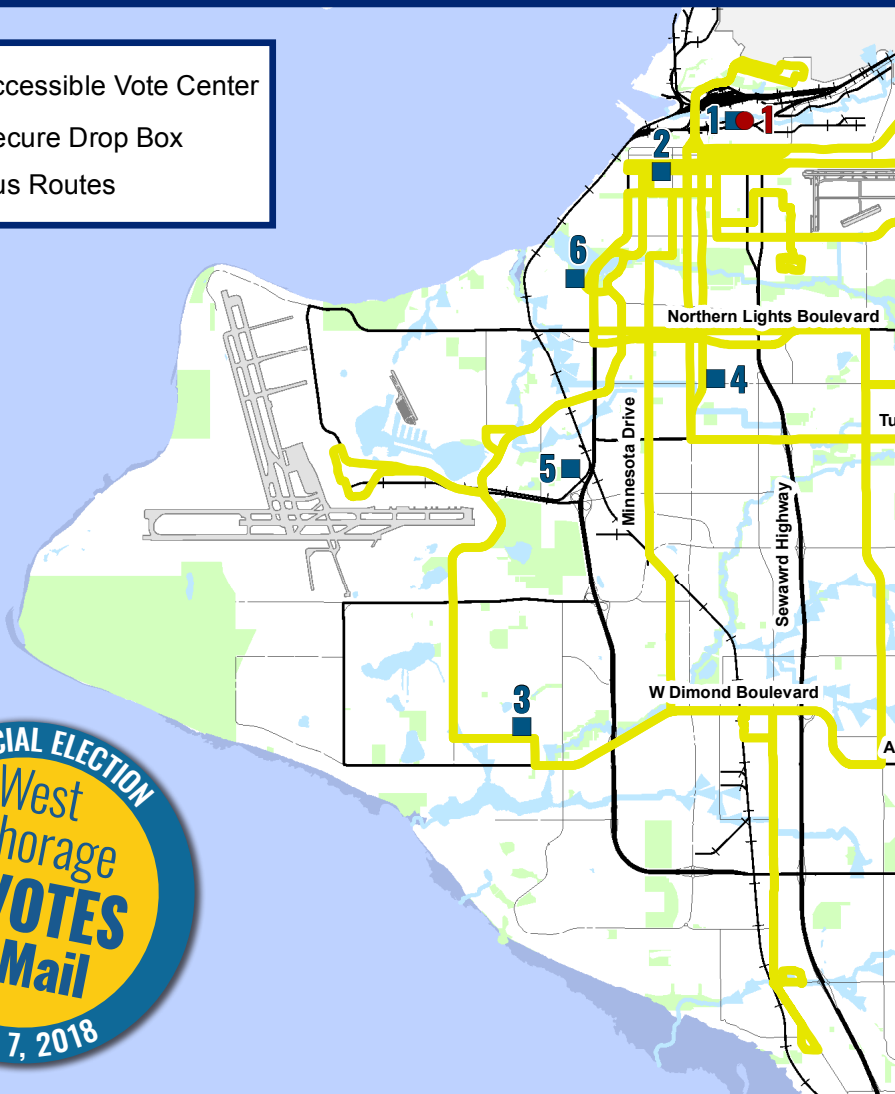
