NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR ASSEMBLY DISTRICT 3 – WEST ANCHORAGE, SEAT E

August 7, 2018

A special election of the Municipality of Anchorage will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018 to fill Assembly Seat E, representing Assembly District 3 –West Anchorage. The election is a by-mail election. Traditional polling places will not be open and are not an option for voting on Election Day.

Registered voters of the State of Alaska who reside within the Municipality of Anchorage Assembly District 3 –West Anchorage are eligible to vote in this election. You may view a map of Assembly Districts at muni.org/AssemblyDistrictMap and a precinct map at muni.org/elections/SampleBallot.

Ballot packages were mailed on July 17 to qualified, registered Assembly District 3 –West Anchorage voters. Voters should follow the instructions included in the ballot package. After filling out the ballot, voters may:

- (1) place the ballot return envelope in one of six Secure Drop Boxes across the Municipality; or
- (2) bring the ballot return envelope to the Accessible Vote Center; or
- (3) mail the ballot return envelope by using first class postage through the United States Postal Service.

Secure Drop Boxes are available for voters to return their ballot at any time before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. You may view a map of Secure Drop Box locations at muni.org/elections/dropbox.

Voters may obtain the following services at an Accessible Vote Center: Return a mailed ballot envelope containing a voted ballot; vote in-person if you lost, damaged, or did not receive a ballot package in the mail; vote a questioned or provisional ballot; receive voting assistance; and to get help with other voter questions.

Candidates' names will appear in a non-sequential alphabetical order on the ballot. Voters may vote for a candidate listed by filling in the oval beside the candidate they wish to vote for, or by filling in the oval beside the Write-in and writing in the name of a qualified person.
