AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 28.40.010B
REDUCING THE AMOUNT OF BALLOT STOCK ORDERED BY THE MUNICIPAL CLERK.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:


Section 1. That Anchorage Municipal Code Section 28.40.010 B is hereby
amended to read:

28.40.010 FORM

B. The municipal clerk shall ensure that ballots are prepared for at least [80] 70 percent
of the registered voters within each precinct to present all candidates and
propositions to the voters. Calculations shall be based on a list prepared by the state
at least 60 days but no more than 90 days before an election. The ballots shall be
consecutively numbered in series.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and
approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
