Unsworn falsification in the second degree. "A person commits the crime of unsworn falsification in the second degree if, with the intent to mislead a public servant in the performance of a duty, the person submits a false written or recorded statement that the person does not believe to be true... on a form bearing notice, authorized by law, that false statements made in it are punishable. Unsworn falsification in the second degree is a class A misdemeanor. A.S. 11.56.210(2) and (2)(b).

Shall Anchorage Municipal code section 26.40.050- Fluoridation of water be amended by adding subsection D (all added language is bold and underlined) [D. All manufacturers supplying the fluoridating chemical shall provide the public with an accurate list of all contaminants and their amounts for each batch sold to the municipal water utility, a detailed toxicological report on the fluoridating chemical, and a written verification of the chemical's safety for ingestion by all water consumers.]?

This amendment will be effective immediately upon certification of the election.

26.40.050 - Fluoridation of water.

A.

The manager of the utility is authorized and directed to continue supplementing the fluoride content of the water supply, to maintain a level of not more than 1.3 parts per million.

B.

All techniques used to apply fluoride, including testing the water before and after the addition of fluoride, determining the fluoride content, and testing for purity of the fluoride chemicals, shall, in all respects, comply with the rules and standards set by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, and the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations.

C. The personnel who will make the necessary analyses and apply the fluoride will be state-certified water treatment operators.

<u>D.</u>

All manufacturers supplying the fluoridating chemical shall provide the public with an accurate list of all contaminants and their amounts for each batch sold to the municipal water utility, a detailed toxicological report on the fluoridating chemical, and a written verification of the chemical's safety for ingestion by all water consumers.
