The Municipal Clerk's Office is grateful to the 600 plus election workers and many others who assisted our office in working on the many issues related to the 2013 Regular Municipal Election.

The Clerk's Office is currently working with the Election Commission to determine the timeline and process for the review and counting the absentee and questioned ballots. The municipal code provides that the review of the questioned ballots begins the day after the election, and the Election Commission has done so and will continue its review from approximately 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. in City Hall, Suite 105. The review will continue Monday- Friday until completed.

On Thursday, April 11, 2013, from 6:00-7:00 p.m. or until complete, the Election Commission shall conduct the public canvass of the questioned and absentee ballots to be rejected. On Friday, April 12, 2013, it is anticipated that the Election Commission will begin counting the questioned and absentee ballots. The counting will continue day to day until completed. The public is welcome to attend.

The Municipal Clerk's office will provide updates to the timeline and processes for the review of ballots.
