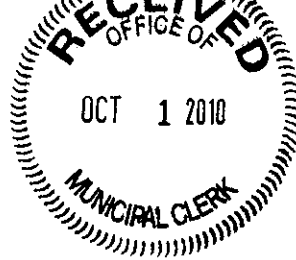

The situation is:

I am the head coach for the Service High School Rifle Team. I am also a trained gunsmith in precision air rifles, and a federally licensed firearms dealer.

In regards to providing gunsmithing service for precision air guns, it is pertinent to know that there are no gunsmiths in the Anchorage area who can provide this service. This means that any repairs to air guns, like those used by the rifle team members, must be sent out of state, adding dollars and time to the cost of repairs.

As to selling pellets and targets: I order only what my fellow ASD rifle coaches request. The order is made once a year for ASD. The volume on this annual order keeps the cost of the product and shipping lower than if the individual coaches placed orders exclusively for their team. My markup on this service is less than 1%. I am providing this service to help keep the overall cost of the riflery program to a minimum.
