Fund Balance Background

What is Fund Balance?

Fund Balance Statements

➤ Within governmental funds, equity is reported as fund balance. Fund balance and net position are the difference between fund assets plus deferred outflows of resources and liabilities plus deferred inflows of resources reflected on the balance sheet or statement of net position

Unassigned Fund Balance

➤ Unassigned fund balance is the **residual classification** for the general fund after the amounts for the nonspendable, restricted, committed, and assigned classifications have been identified. For the general fund, unassigned fund balance may represent either a positive or negative balance.

Fund Balance Policy

The most recent amended Fund Balance Policy was established pursuant to AR 2015-84 approved on March 24, 2015.

- Fund Balance Policy:
 - Unrestricted General Fund balance in an amount equal to 10% of current year expenditures in its General Government fund budgets.
 - Unrestricted General Fund balance in an amount equal to 8.25% of current year expenditures in its non-major Government Operating Funds.
 - Unrestricted fund balances in its 5 major funds in an amount between 2.0% and 3.0% of current year expenditures as a Working Capital Reserve.
