PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Purpose/Summary of amendments: To include toys as a juvenile product to which the prohibition applies.

TEXT OF AMENDMENT

AO Page 7, beginning at line 5; amending as follows:

Juvenile product means a new, not a previously owned, product designed for residential use by infants and children under 12 years of age, including but not limited to a bassinet, booster seat, changing pad, toys, floor play mat, highchair, highchair pad, infant bouncer, infant carrier, infant seat, infant swing, infant walker, nursing pad, nursing pillow, playpen side pad, portable hook-on chair, stroller, and children's nap mat. **Juvenile product does not include child or infant restraint systems [~~toys~~] or clothing.**
