AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY TO PROTECT THE HEALTH OF CHILDREN AND FIREFIGHTERS BY AMENDING THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 15.100, *CONSUMER PRODUCTS*, AND A NEW SECTION TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN CONSUMER PRODUCTS CONTAINING FLAME RETARDANT CHEMICALS HARMFUL TO HUMAN HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENT.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Purpose/Summary of amendments: To clarify that any federal standard adopted by the Consumer Products Safety Commission that would apply to any “covered product” as defined in this ordinance will be incorporated by reference and enforceable under this Code.

TEXT OF AMENDMENT

AO Page 3, beginning at line 30; amending as follows:

1. For purposes of this subsection, any consumer product safety standard adopted under federal law that establishes allowable levels of a prohibited flame retardant chemical that covered products may contain is presumed to establish the maximum allowable level of the chemical that may be used in *in a covered product* ~~[children's products]~~ that are sold or offered for sale in the municipality, and the federally established level **if equally or more protective** is hereby incorporated by reference and may be enforced under this section.
