11/16/18: A new complainant called and said the MJ odor from cannabaska has been very strong. C works across the street in one of the establishments. He indicated that it did smell this morning at about 11 a.m. He also said that he would keep a log of when he smelled it. (ktc)

11/19/18: Inspected cannabaska yesterday and did not detect any MJ smell around the property. (ktc)

11/26/2018          Inspection                                  K.Collins

11/26/18:

I inspected cannabaska today and did not detect any MJ smell around the property. I did detect a slight odor along the north property line. This did not persist during the 15 minutes I was there. Time approx. 1350 wind from the SW. (ktc)

11/27/2018          Inspection                                  K.Collins

11/27/18: I inspected the perimeter of the Alaska Sense facility at approx. 1510 and did not detect any marijuana odor. (ktc)

11/28/2018          Inspection                                  R.Fern

On 11-16-18 at approximately 1200 hrs Officer Quiboloy-Reid was at the Bering Street Maintenance Facility and spent approximately 15 minutes directly adjacent to Alaskasense and did not detect the odor of MJ coming from the facility. RAF
