## Subject: Ethics Complaint for Potential Violation 2022-09

<u>Allegation</u>: Violation of AMC 1.15.060 – Conflict of Interest; and AMC 1.15.110 – Use of Municipal Resources for Political or Partisan Activity

On July 29, 2022, the Board of Ethics ("the Board") received Ethics Complaint for Potential Violation 2022-09. The complainant made a number of allegations against an assembly member, including that the assembly member had a conflict of interest, engaged in degrading behavior, filed a false police report, violated public trust by using vulgar language, and violated public trust by presenting an ordinance to usurp voters and the will of the people.

After considering the complaint, the Board declined to review it further pursuant to AMC 1.15.160(A)(2)(b) and (g). The Board determined the allegations related to matters that are outside the jurisdiction of the board or would be better handled in another forum, or the allegations, if true, fail to constitute a violation of the code of ethics.
