AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY REDUCING THE THIRTY-DAY PERIOD FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT ON AR 2013-307, APPROVING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND PUBLIC EMPLOYEES, LOCAL 71

WHEREAS, the Administration of the Municipality of Anchorage and Public Employees, Local 71 have entered into a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) and submitted the CBA for approval under AR 2013-307 for reading at the November 19, 2013 Assembly meeting; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the agreement are effective January 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) subsection 3.70.090D.3.c. requires the Assembly "shall have a 30-day period for public review and comment on the labor agreement terms and conditions, summary of economic effects, and contract changes, before action by the assembly"; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial to reduce the 30-day public review and comment period to avoid retroactive payments of wage adjustments that if approved are payable the first full pay period of 2014; now, therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding AMC subsection 3.70.090D.3.c., the Assembly may take action on AR 2013-307 in less than 30 days from its introduction.

Section 2. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage and approval.
