AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17, SECTION 17.05.010 DEFINITIONS, TO REDEFINE CHRONIC ANIMAL NOISE; AMENDING SECTION 17.10.015 ANIMALS CREATING DISTURBANCE OR NUISANCE; AND AMENDING SECTION 17.15.090 INSPECTIONS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Anchorage Municipal Code section 17.05.010 is hereby amended to read as follows (the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out):

17.05.010 Definitions, generally.

Chronic animal noise means repeated vocalization by an animal or animals [IN A 60 MINUTE PERIOD] from the time the noise begins for more than five [SEVEN] consecutive minutes during the daytime noise period from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and more than five consecutive minutes during the nighttime noise period from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. A licensed commercial or multi animal facility, as defined below, licensed for four or more dogs shall be excused from the five [SEVEN] consecutive minutes limit for daytime noise only, up to four times per day, for a maximum of 20 consecutive minutes each time provided that no 20-minute period shall occur within one hour of any other 20-minute period.
