FROM: MAYOR 1 2 3 SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION DISSOLVING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT 4 10-10, WHICH CONSTRUCTED STREET IMPROVEMENTS TO 5 ALEXANDER AVENUE BETWEEN COLUMBINE STREET AND 6 NORENE STREET, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. 7 8 On March 29, 2011, the Assembly approved AO 2011-26 creating special 9 assessment district 10-10 for street reconstruction and storm drain improvements 10 to Alexander Avenue between Columbine Street and Norene Street (Exhibit 1). 11 This ordinance specified that 90% of the project cost would be paid by the 12 Municipality and the remaining 10% would be paid by benefiting property owners 13 through special assessments. 14 15 However, the Municipality of Anchorage received a state grant in 2011 that was 16 for the purpose of the Alexander Avenue road reconstruction and specifically 17 would be applied to any assessments encumbered by the property owners. 18 19 The assessable share for the district is \$172,498.77, which is less than the 20 \$250,000 grant from the State of Alaska. 21 22 Therefore, as the potential property owner assessments have been paid by 23 means of a state grant, and the project is complete, the Assembly Resolution will 24 dissolve special assessment district 10-10. 25 26 Passage of this resolution will have no fiscal impact on any Municipal property. 27 28 THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS APPROVAL. 29 30 Prepared by: J.W.
