Remember to **register to vote** or **update your voter registration** on or before the **Sunday, March 5, 2017 deadline.**

Register to Vote. Any qualified Alaska voter and Anchorage resident at least seventeen years and nine months old may register, but you must be eighteen years old on April 4, 2017 for your vote to count in the Municipal Election. A voter registration application is online at <https://voterregistration.alaska.gov/>. For more information about registering to vote, call the Alaska Division of Elections at 907-522-8683.

Update your Voter Registration. If your voter information has changed, you must update your information by Sunday, March 5, 2017, in order for the change to take effect in time for the Municipal Election on April 4, 2017. A voter registration application is online at <https://voterregistration.alaska.gov/>. For more information about updating your voter information, call the Alaska Division of Elections at 907-522-8683.

Absentee Voting. If you cannot vote in person on Election Day at your designated polling location, absentee voting is available by mail, by fax, and in person. Applications for absentee voting by mail and fax can be printed directly from the Municipal Elections website, www.muni.org/elections, or an absentee application can be sent to you by calling 907-243-VOTE or by emailing elections@muni.org. Absentee in person sites are listed below. Qualified voters who are physically unable to vote at a polling place may request, through a representative, a Special Needs Ballot.

Early Voting. Voting begins March 20, 2017 at City Hall and the Loussac Library. All ballot styles will be available. Voting begins at Chugiak Senior Center on March 27, 2017. Only Chugiak/Eagle River ballot styles will be available. More information about early voting is available at www.muni.org/elections

On Election Day. On April 4, 2017, vote at your designated polling location. If you are unable to get to your designated polling location, you may vote an absentee ballot at City Hall (New for 2017!), the Loussac Library, the South Terminal of the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport, or at the UAA Student Center. All ballot styles will be available at absentee voting locations.
