The Municipal Clerk's Office has developed the timeline for the public canvass and counting the absentee and questioned ballots for the April 7, 2015 Regular Municipal Election.

On Friday, April 10, 2015 in City Hall, Room 105 beginning at 12:00 noon, the Election Commission and Election Officials will begin counting the early and absentee in-person ballots as well as the absentee by mail ballots. The counting will continue day to day until completed. The additional absentee results will be uploaded as soon as the counting is complete.

On Wednesday, April 15, 2015 in City Hall, Room #830 beginning at 5:30 p.m. until complete, the Election Commission will hold the public canvass; the Election Commission will review the questioned and absentee ballots to be rejected.

On Thursday, April 16, 2015 in City Hall, Room 105, it is anticipated that election officials will begin counting the questioned ballots. The counting will continue day to day until completed. The unofficial final election results will be uploaded as soon as the counting is complete.

The meetings are open to the public.

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
