ORDINANCE NO. AO 98-33

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,905,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF PUBLIC SAFETY (POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES) AND RELAT-ED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA AT AN ELEC-TION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ON APRIL 21, 1998.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed Two Million Nine Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$2,905,000) for the purpose of paying the costs of planning, designing, acquiring property for, equipping, rehabilitating and constructing Anchorage Police Department facilities, purchasing crime mapping modules and a crime lab processor, and upgrading communication systems and related police protection capital improvements within the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area.

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed Two Million Nine Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$2,905,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality of Anchorage for the aforesaid public safety (police protection services) and related police protection capital improvements, and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used for capital improvements only. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the

27 28 payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property in the Municipality shall be levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due. The principal of and interest on the bonds are to be paid first from general ad valorem taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area.

Section 3. An election is to be held on April 21, 1998, in and for the Municipality of Anchorage, for the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question, both in the Metropolitan Anchorage Police Service Area and areawide, to be approved. The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

PROPOSITION NO.

ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA PUBLIC SAFETY (POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES) AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$2,905,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay costs of planning, designing, acquiring property for, equipping, rehabilitating and constructing Anchorage Police Department facilities, purchasing crime mapping modules and a crime lab processor, and upgrading communication systems, and related police protection capital improvements within the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area? These capital improvements would be located in the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area.

The annual increase in taxes on \$100,000 of assessed real and personal property value (based on the estimated 1998, assessed valuation in the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area) necessary to retire the proposed debt is approximately \$3.59.

The debt levied will be paid from individual and property taxes levied and collected in the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area. Anchorage will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the debt.
