AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SUBSECTION 17.10.050A. REGULATING THE RESTRAINT OF ANIMALS IN PUBLIC PLACES TO PROVIDE A CONDITIONAL EXCEPTION FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF CONTROL BY LEASH FOR PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED OWNERS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Section 1: That Anchorage Municipal Code section 17.10.050A. is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection 4. to read as follows:

17.10.050 Animals in public places.

A. Subject to other provisions of this title and except for classified animals and wolf hybrids, an owner shall have his animal under control by leash and shall not leave such animal unattended within a public vehicular or pedestrian way or public place except:

4. When the owner is physically handicapped in such a manner that reasonably prevents or unreasonably impedes the use of a leash, provided the animal is under control by command.

(The remaining subsections of this section are not affected by this ordinance and are therefore not set out.)
