AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.30.172 TO
CLASSIFY EXECUTIVE POSITIONS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code subsections 3.30.172E, F and G are hereby amended to
read as follows: *(the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out)*

3.30.172 **Classification.**

B For the purpose of establishing the appropriate compensation for executive
classifications, six ranges have been established: 20E (for assembly-appointed
classifications), 21E (E-1), 22E (E-2) and 23E (E-3), 24E (E-4) and 25E (E-5).
Assignment of a classification to one of the six ranges is based on the appointing
authority, level and scope of responsibility for policy development and public
advocacy, and particular training and experience necessary to perform the duties.

The classifications assigned to range 22E, subject to appointment by the mayor, or
by the Anchorage Equal Rights Commission or the police and fire retirement board
subject to the approval of the mayor are:

* **Risk Manager**

The classifications assigned to range 23E, subject to appointment by the mayor,
are:

* **Director, Customer Service.**

* **Director, Project Management.**

G The classifications assigned to range 24E, subject to appointment by the mayor
are:

* **Executive Director, Community Service and Development.**
