A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY URGING THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE TO ALLOW THE PUBLIC TO USE ITS DOWNTOWN PARKING LOT FOR EVENING AND WEEKEND PARKING

WHEREAS, continued development of downtown Anchorage has made public parking scarce and expensive; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage allows the public to use its City Hall parking lot for evening and weekend parking; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Court System has also opened up its parking lots to the public for evening and weekend parking; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature operates a downtown parking lot containing more than 100 accessible spaces which could also be made available to the public for evening and weekend parking; and

WHEREAS, evening and weekend use of the Legislature's parking area by the public will encourage further development of downtown Anchorage by making downtown accessible to residents and visitors using private transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the Alaska Legislature is urged to make its downtown parking lot located at 716 W. 4th Avenue available for public parking on evenings and weekends.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this resolution is effective upon passage and approval.
