A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF FORTY THREE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$43,500) TO THE MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (261) FROM ALASKANS FOR LITTER PREVENTION AND RECYCLING FOR THE MUNICIPAL COMMUNITY WORK SERVICE PROGRAM.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Anchorage Assembly Resolves:

Section 1. That a Forty Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollar Grant from Alaskans for Litter Prevention and Recycling for the hiring of persons to assist in the supervision of the Community Work Service Program and to operate the Youth Litter Patrol and Cigarette Butt Patrol Program in 2000 is appropriated to the Miscellaneous Operational Grants Fund (261).
