A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE MODIFYING THE CONDITIONS  
OF RENEWAL FOR THE BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LIQUOR LICENSE FOR ANNA'S PLACE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

WHEREAS, on May 31, 2000, the Anchorage Assembly passed AR 2000-160 (as amended) which imposed conditions on the renewal of the license and waived its protest of the renewal. One of the conditions imposed requires Anna's Place to close at midnight on weekdays and 1:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly and the owner of Anna's Place agree that so long as no alcohol is served after the hours of midnight on weekdays and 1:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday and the alcohol is placed in a locked storage area or cabinet, Anna's Place should be allowed to remain open for food service;

NOW THEREFORE,

Section 1. AR 2000-160 (as amended) is amended to require alcohol sales to cease by midnight on weekdays and 1:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. All alcohol shall immediately therewith be locked in a storage area or cabinet. The closing hours mandated by AR 2000-160 (as amended) are hereby revoked.

Section 2. That this resolution is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
