WHEREAS, before Alaska's voters at the November 7, 2000 general election is the question of whether to approve Statewide Ballot Measure 4, a proposition which would limit property assessment and taxation by municipalities throughout Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Proposition #4 would remove local control of property tax rates and would place local decisions over taxation and expenditures into the hands of State officials; and

WHEREAS, Proposition #4 would limit sources of repayment for new general obligation bonds issued for construction of public facilities, thereby eliminating voter-approved bonds as a means of financing construction of needed schools, fire stations, and other public facilities; and

WHEREAS, the 10 mill limit on local property taxes imposed by Proposition #4 would require many local governments in Alaska, including the Municipality of Anchorage, to substantially reduce essential public services such as police protection, fire protection, education, street maintenance and snow removal; and

WHEREAS, Proposition #4 would also require local governments throughout Alaska to cut or eliminate public services necessary to the preservation of the quality of life for local residents such as parks and recreation programs, health services, libraries and cultural amenities, and transportation; and

WHEREAS, implementation of Proposition #4 with its limits on annual adjustments to assessment of real property would create inequities in assessment of real property throughout Alaska.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves that:

Section 1: The Assembly urges voters to vote against Ballot Measure #4 at the general election of November 7, 2000

Section 2: This resolution takes effect upon passage and approval.
