WHEREAS, Susan's vision for progressive benefit programs and employee services contributed to her successful management of the Employee Records and Benefits Division for more than 20 years; and


WHEREAS, on October 24, 2000, Susan J. Lindemuth retired from the Municipality of Anchorage after 30 years of service.
