WHEREAS, Mahala Ashley Dickerson graduated cum laude from Howard University in 1948 and was Alabama's first Black female attorney, admitted in 1948; and

WHEREAS, she was the first Black attorney to pioneer the last great frontier and was admitted to the Alaska Bar in 1959; and

WHEREAS, she homesteaded 160 acres of land in the Matanuska-Susitna Valley; and

WHEREAS, she is the founder of Al-Acres, Inc., a charitable, educational, and religious corporation, to which she also devotes a part of her homestead for recreational, charitable, and religious purposes; and

WHEREAS, she has completed her memoirs, "Delayed Justice For Sale", profits from which go to Al-Acres, Inc. for the benefit of scholarships for needy college students and for civil rights causes; and

WHEREAS, she has practiced law in Alaska for 42 years, dedicating much of her time and energy to assisting minorities, women, and the underprivileged in achieving equality in housing, employment, and human services; and

WHEREAS, Mahala Ashley Dickerson has received numerous awards including the Zeta Phi Beta "Woman of the Year Award", the NAACP "Freedom Award", the Valley Women's Resource Center "Women's History Award", the Northern Lights Civic and Social Club "Mother of the Year Award", the Denali Alaskan of the Year Award, induction into the Lawyer's Hall of Fame by the National Bar Association in 1999, and the National Bar Association's Scroll Award in 2001, given for outstanding service by Black women attorneys who have served over 50 years.
