In 2004, the Mayor appointed the Hollywood Vista Task Force, primarily of Government Hill residents, to oversee the planning process for an area on Government Hill formerly known as Hollywood Vista. The blighted Hollywood Vista site was demolished in 1997 and Government Hill residents desire future redevelopment to include single family home ownership.

The process to redevelop the site is now underway. A developer was chosen through Requests For Proposals, and a site plan developed with construction slated to begin in spring 2007.

Before construction begins, gravel must be extracted from the site. The Municipality, the Alaska Railroad and the Port of Anchorage worked extensively with the Government Hill community to find a gravel haul road route with the least amount of impact to the neighborhood.

In order to stay on schedule and begin construction this spring, a waiver of the conditional use permit requirement for resource extraction is required. This AO also waives the requirement for a grading, excavation and fill permit, imposed by title 23.

The waiver does not change a requirement for the site plan to be submitted to the Planning and Zoning Commission and others, as outlined in AO 97-101; the waiver of the conditional use permit provision allows the project to proceed now.

Conditions of Operation for Gravel Extraction Tak'atnu Development on Government Hill, 2007

The following terms will apply to the gravel extraction portion of the Tak'atnu development on Government Hill beginning Spring 2007:

Jaguar Development Group, LLC agrees to the following:

1. Hours of operation shall be:

School days: 9:30 am to 3pm and 4-7pm

Saturdays: 7am - 7pm

After school dismisses for summer: 7am - 7pm

Sundays: none Holidays: none

2. Hours of operations of including maintenance shall occur only at the times and dates stated

3. Gravel extraction must be completed by July 15th, 2007

4. Regular street sweeping shall be required where trucks enter public roadways and in other areas along haul route as needed. All street sweeping will be a wet sweep, preceded by water application, to minimize dust.

5. Tire wash and or truck grooming and cleaning before trucks leave the site.

6. Compliance with all load limits set forth in AMC Title 9 and seasonal weight restrictions (a percentage of legal allowable weight and shall be applied to the maximum axle loading of 17 AAC 25.013(e).) as posted by Alaska State Department of Transportation and the Municipality of Anchorage.

7. Signs shall be posted at the job site and shall be viewable by the public and shall list contact names and phone numbers of municipal officials and the developer so that

individuals can report concerns or complaints.

8. At the end of the extraction period, a summary shall be complied and include some of the following information: area dug, amounts of material removed, areas restored, etc.

The Municipality of Anchorage agrees to the following:

1. Municipal officials will determine any action or corrective measures needed and address the concerns immediately.

2. All complaints received by the municipality shall be relayed via e-mail to the Government

Hill Community Council president.

- 3. Residents living adjacent to excavation site and adjacent to haul route will be informed by mail of the project's purpose, duration of excavation operation, hours of operation and contact information.
- 4. Once title to the property know as "Defense Fuels Property" is transferred from the Department of Defense to the Port of Anchorage (POA), the port shall work with the GHCC and the MOA to develop a site plan for the area including but not limited to landscaping, seeding fencing, vehicle pullouts, bollards etc.

5. The MOA shall work with the POA and the Alaska Railroad Corporation on the demolition of the building known as the "Detail Shop" in order to accommodate a haul route for the gravel extraction previous to hauling gravel to the port.

6. Any damage to the paved road portions of the haul route due to truck traffic will be

repaired before the end of Summer 2007.

7. This agreement will be filed with the Planning & Zoning Commission and infractions will be enforceable by Zoning Enforcement.

The Government Hill Community Council agrees to the following:

1. GHCC shall submit a resolution to the Planning & Zoning Commission addressing overall approval of the development plan for the Tak'atnu development (formerly known as Hollywood Vista).

2. GHCC supports the passage of AO 2007-57 an ordinance waiving permitting requirements in AMC Tiles 21 and 23 in a R-3 SL district with special limitations (AO

97-101) for Tract 2A Hollywood Vista Subdivision.

The Port of Anchorage agrees to the following:

1. The Port of Anchorage shall develop a gravel haul road in a way to have the least impact to the neighborhood.

2. The gravel haul road penetrating the fence along Bluff Drive and crossing the former defense fuels site will be abandoned immediately following the July 15th gravel extraction deadline.

3. The defense fuels haul road shall not be reopened to access port facilities, port construction projects or neighboring industrial projects in the port area. It is understood that this road is temporary and is to serve the Hollywood Vista gravel extraction project exclusively.

4. Once title to the property know as "Defense Fuels Property" is transferred from the Department of Defense to the Port of Anchorage, the Port shall work with the GHCC to develop a site plan for the area including but not limited to landscaping, seeding fencing, vehicle pullouts, bollards etc.
