Project Description: This project will increase visibility for pedestrian and bicycle traffic through the installation of lighting on Minnesota Drive between Tudor and 15th Avenue.

The purpose of this safety project is to reduce pedestrian and bicycle crashes, and other traffic incidences, by installing lighting. The proposed improvements are consistent with the Alaska Strategic Highway Safety Plan, Special Users Strategies, and MOA Vision Zero Safety Goals.

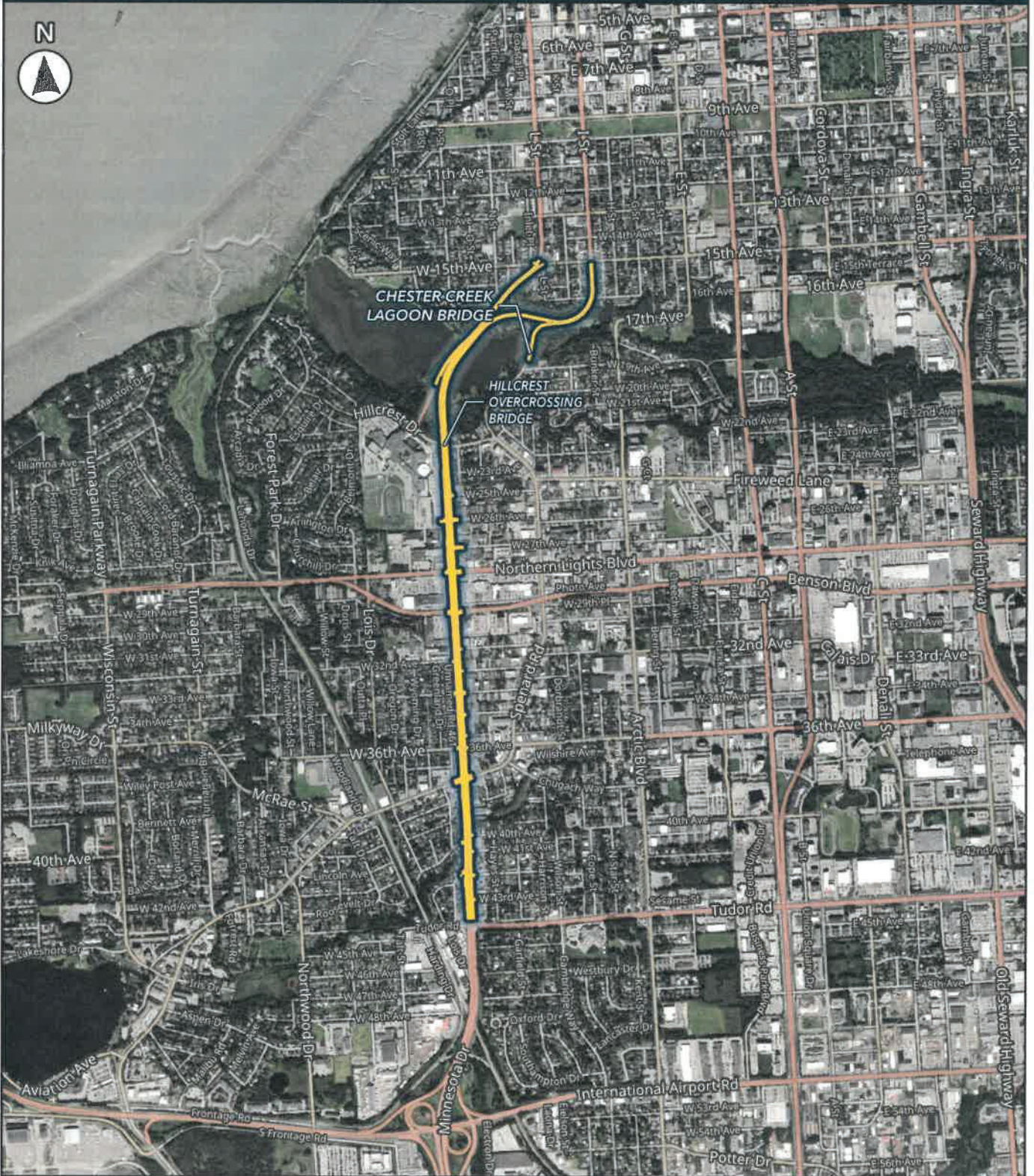
