Section 5307.Please note, for those nominating multiple projects it is important to prioritize them; AMATS recommends the following steps:

- 1. Review and discuss the merits of the existing projects.
- 2. Suggest additional projects or deletions, if needed.
- 3. Develop an overall priority ranking for all projects you submit.
- 4. Submit your nomination(s) to AMATS so they can be ranked and scored using the approved ranking criteria.
