### General Situation

Anchorage July 26, 2019 1500

- MOA Assembly voted on 7/26/19 at 11:30am to extend the Civil Emergency Declaration to 8/6/19 to 11:59pm.
- MOA Assembly voted on 7/26 at 11:30am to appropriate \$400,000 to Catholic Social Services (CSS) for BFS services to continue services at 240 bed capacity without shutting down.
  - Money is coming from November and December cold weather shelter fund.
- The Red Cross of Alaska is prepared to manage a shelter from August 1-4, 2019 while working on transitioning the shelter to another management organization.
  - Salvation Army will support with food service operations at the shelter
- Agencies Reported the following:
  - Beans Café –EOC Operations Chief reached out to Beans Café to coordinate sanitation issues.
  - Anchorage Hospitals –Remain on standby for a potential medical surge event
  - Salvation Army-Identified a gymnasium which can accommodate 100 shelter beds.
