General Situation

Anchorage, July 31, 2019

- Food Coalition meeting—clients served are increasing at food pantries and community kitchens.
 - Beans Café has served 2000 more meals per month (400 pounds of food per day)
 - 211 seeing a two fold increase in calls for food pantry referrals
 - All food pantries are predicted to have an increase of clients as time passes
 - Area churches are growing food to provide to pantries
 - School backpack program held on Aug 15, 2019 will be used to gauge probable increase need of services.
 - The Nixle message from AFD was discussed at the meeting and participants encouraged to share the message.
- United Way/Anchorage Coalition to End Homelessness will coordinate information resources for volunteer and donation services and request service providers share the information.
 - Hits on the www.bethechange907.org site went from 34 hits to 487 after the Nixle was released by AFD on July 30, 2019.
- Transportation options being assessed to transport clients from Clare House to Downtown Hope Center.
