## Haul It Yourself

Take your organic materials to a composting facility, recycling facility, or wood lot. Call for fees, hours, dates, and an updated list of acceptable materials.

Accepts: grass and leaves. No wood please! Call for a quote for horse manure.

Fee: \$2/bag; \$10/pick-up truck load; or \$10/cubic yard for large volumes -- **SEASONAL SITE**

**Muni Wood Lots (Eagle River/Girdwood)** 267-4980

Accepts: Brush and woody debris from the clearing of defensible space from wildfire only. No lot clearing, 8' lengths or less, less than 8" diameter, no stumps. Fee: Free\* -- **SEASONAL SITES**

**Anchorage Soil & Water Conservation District (ASWCD) Wood Lot (Anchorage)**

Accepts: Brush and woody debris. 8' lengths or less.

Fee: Call for this year's fees -- **SEASONAL SITE**

**One-day drop-off event held in August each year.** At the Alaska Botanical Garden (off Campbell Airstrip Road, 1 block S. of Tudor) during the one-day event in August. Two categories of pots are accepted: #2 HDPE pots and #5 PP, #6 PS and #7 Other pots, cell packs and trays. Be sure all pots are free of loose dirt and other materials.
