Eagle River Area Snow Disposal Site Goal: CBERRSA needs additional snow storage capacity. Scope: This project will construct a snow disposal facility serving the Chugiak, Birchwood, Eagle River Rural Road Service Area (CBERRRSA). Status: No work is underway, However, a 2007 state grant has been requested for site selection, acquisition, and preliminary engineering funding. **Eagle River CBD Circulation Study** Concern has been expressed about options for improving circulation in the Eagle River CBD Goal: area. The project will conduct a comprehensive circulation study for the entire road network within Scope: the downtown core of Eagle River. The study will include an assessment of pedestrian improvement needs, access management alternatives, the need for improved co No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. However, the Status: project has been added to Capital Project Needs List for evaluation and prioritization. Eagle River Chugiak Road and Drainage System Rehab Goal: Road and drainage needs existing throughout the service area. Scope: Construct road and drainage improvements. The Chugiak, Birchwood, Eagle River Rural Road Service Area Board manages funding Status: collected through property taxes for road and drainage improvements in their area. The local

road board evaluates and prioritizes projects for funding.

Goal: Scope: Collector improvements typically include a new road base, pavement, curbs, underground drainage, street lights, and pedestrian facilities. Status: Design is substantially completed and construction by the State of Alaska is expected to start in 2007 or 2008. This is a state owned facility. Eagle River Rd Trail Rehab - Old Glenn Hwy to Mile Hi Rd The existing trail is showing its age and is no longer cost effective to maintain. Goal: Scope: This project will rehabilitate the Eagle River Road Trail from the Old Glenn Highway to Mile Hi Road. Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state route and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. Eagle River Rd Upgrade - Old Glenn Hwy to Greenhouse Rd (MP5.3ish) Future vehicle and pedestrian traffic may require the expansion of this facility. Goal: Scope: Not set. Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. **EXPAND EAGLE RIVER-SOUTHFORK VFS** Goal: 2007-Expand/renovate the Eagle River Southfork Volunteer auxiliary Fire Station to better Scope: accomodate the personnel and provide additional on-site training space. Tentative scope would include expanding both north and south directions from 2-lane to 3-lane Scope: configurations. No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state Status: owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. Glenn Hwy Hightower Lighting - Hiland Rd to South Birchwood Loop Interest in improved lighting on the Glenn Highway has been expressed. Goal: Install improved lighting. Scope: Status: A state grant was provided for the phase I of these improvements. This is a state owned facility and the project is being managed by the State of Alaska. Future funding is uncertain. Glenn Hwy Lane Expansion - Hiland Rd to Artillery Rd Traffic volumes have continued to climb on one of the busiest road segments in Alaska. Goal: Frequent incidents along the roadway slow traffic to inefficient levels. Scope: This project would add an additional traffic lane in each direction to the Glenn Highway from Hiland Road to Artillery Road. This would include widening or replacing the two bridges crossing Eagle River. In addition, the interchanges with Hiland Road an No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state Status: owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. Glenn Hwy Rut Repairs - McCarrey St to Artillery Rd Goal: Pavement is deteriorating. Overlay the pavement. Scope: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state Status: owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. Glenn Hwy Trail Rehabilitation - Muldoon Rd to North Birchwood Lp Goal: The trail has deteriorated to the point that maintenance is no longer cost effective. Scope: This project will resurface the existing trail, formalize a parking facility near the weigh station, and construct a memorial pull-out. Status: No work is underway. However, design funding is tentatively planned for 2008 or 2009 through

the AMATS TIP. This is a state owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the

State of Alaska.

Mausel, Banff, Targhee Street Reconstruction (CBERRRSA) Goal: These local roads are deteriorating. Scope: Reconstruct local roads.
