South Addition

Rank #

10th Ave Surface Rehab - P St to Ingra St

Goal: Pavement condition is deteriorating.

Scope: Replace or overlay the pavement along with ADA sidewalk and curb rehab.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program.

16th Ave Pedestrian Activated Crossing Light at A St

Goal: Pedestrian safety concerns have been raised regarding the "A" Street crossing at 16th Avenue.

Scope: Potentially installing a pedestrian activated crossing light.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. The project has been added to Capital Project Needs List for evaluation and prioritization.

16th Ave Upgrade - E St to C St

Goal: This road is in poor condition with pavement and some curbs. Drainage, street lighting, and pedestrian facilities are inadequate.

Scope: Reconstruct road to include pavement, curbs, pedestrian facilities, drainage, and street lighting.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. Funding will be through the Road Improvement District program unless reclassified as a collector street.

9th Ave Reconstruction - L St to LaTouche St

Goal: Pavement on this minor arterial street has deteriorated to the point where maintenance is not cost effective. The traffic signal detection loops are deteriorated and the signal system is at the end of its design life.

Scope: Project is being re-scoped and scheduled in conjunction with development of planned improvements to E Street and the Park Strip. Project will include new traffic signals, street illumination, ADA improvements, pedestrian and bike paths and landscape impro

Status: Project re-scoped again to provide for reconstruction to three lane section in 2008 between L Street and LaTouche Street with landscape and hardscape improvements to strengthen pedestrian connection between Fairview and Downtown.

A/C Couplet Pavement Replacement - Port to Tudor Rd

Goal: Pavement is deteriorating.

Scope: Overlay and/or replace pavement.

Status: No work is underway. This is a state owned facility and prioritization and funding would be through the State of Alaska.

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A/C Couplet Restripe to 4-lane - 9th Ave to Tudor Rd

Goal: When constructed, pavement width was constructed to allow for a future restripe to 4-lanes if and when traffic volumes demonstrated the need. No studies have been completed demonstrating the need at this time.

Scope: Eventual restripe from a 3-lane to a 4-lane configuration.

Status: No work is underway. This is a state owned facility.

C St at 20th Ave Drainage

Goal: The existing storm outfall is lower than the creek which causes sedimentation and ice build up in the system. The facility serves a local neighborhood. This project is a priority for street maintenance.

Scope: This project will construct a drainage lift station and a new storm drain outfall into Chester Creek at 20th Avenue.

Status: No work is underway, but a 2007 state grant has been requested.

Chester Creek Aquatic Habitat Restoration - Westchester Lagoon Improvements

Goal: This project will relocate the existing utilities to allow reconstruction of the existing outfall from Westchester Lagoon into Cook Inlet which does not adequately allow for fish passage.

Scope: Phase I of this project will relocate the existing utilities at the Westchester Lagoon outfall into Cook Inlet. Phase II will reconstruct the outfall into Cook Inlet.

Status: Currently working with AWWU for relocation during spring of 2007. Phase II - which will reconstruct the outfall of Westchester Lagoon is being developed. NTP has been given to design engineer.

E St Left-hand Turning Signal at 15th Ave

Goal: Motorists often have to wait more than one cycle at the light in order to make a left hand turn. This affects both north and south bound traffic.

Scope: This project will change the traffic signal at E St and 15th Ave to incorporate left-hand turn lights.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. However, this project has been added to the needs list for future funding consideration by the Traffic Department.

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I St/L St Rut Repair - 3rd Ave to 20th Ave

Goal: This major arterial has an ADT over 15,000. The road surface has pot holes and cracking. Increased deterioration could impact safety. This project is a priority for the state DOT.

Scope: This project will construct pavement rehabilitation improvements on a major arterial street. Improvements are expected to include rut-repair and/or pavement overlay.

Status: No work is underway, but a 2007 state grant has been requested. This is a state owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska.

Minnesota Dr Northbound Expansion - 16th Ave to 26th Ave

Goal: Traffic is expected to continue to increase beyond the capacity of the existing configuration.

Scope: Add a north bound lane.

Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state-owned facility and evaluation and funding would be by the State of Alaska. This project is included in the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP).

P St Surface Rehab - 13th Ave to 15th Ave

Goal: Pavement on this local road is deteriorating.

Scope: Replace or overlay pavement.

Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. Project has been added to Capital Project Needs List for evaluation and prioritization.

Son of Downtown Area Curb Bulb Project (HSIP)

Goal: Safety concerns have been identified at several downtown intersections.

Scope: This project will construct curb bulb improvements to slow traffic at intersections.

Status: Design by the State of Alaska is substantially complete and construction is anticipated in 2007. Funding is through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP).

South Addition Alley Repaving

Goal: Several alleys in the South Addition Community Council area are deteriorating.

Scope: Repave alleys.

Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. The project has been added to the Capital Projects Needs List for future funding consideration. Alley reconstruction is funded through the 90/10 Reconstruction Road Improvement District Program. In this program, property owners initiate the project and agree to pay 10% of the costs through special assessments.

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South Addition Area Pedestrian Scale Street Lighting

Goal: Interest has been expressed in installing pedestrian scale lighting.

Scope: Install pedestrian scale lighting.

Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. Project has been added to Capital Project Needs List for evaluation and prioritization.

South Addition Area Separated Sidewalk

Goal: Interest has been expressed in constructing separated sidewalks in the South Addition area, on 9th/11th, 12th, and 14th Avenues, west of C Street.

Scope: Construct separated sidewalks.

Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. Project has been added to Capital Project Needs List for evaluation and prioritization.

South Addition Sidewalk Rehab

Goal: Sidewalks in the South Addition Community Council area are deteriorating.

Scope: Reconstruct deteriorated sidewalks.

Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. Project has been added to Capital Project Needs List for evaluation and prioritization. Improvements will also be considered for funding through the annual pedestrian safety and rehab program.
