Chugiak-Eagle River Areawide Aquifer Study and Drainage Plan

Problem: Development in this region has produced a need for an areawide plan to handle future drainage needs.

Scope: This project will study the aquifer in the Chugiak-Eagle River area and make drainage plan recommendations.

Status: No work is underway and no funding is proposed in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. The project has been added to the Capital Projects Needs List for future funding consideration.

Citation Rd Upgrade - Eagle River Loop Rd to Eagle River Ln

Problem: This local road has never been constructed to urban standards.

Scope: Upgrade road to urban standards including a new road base, curbs, pavement, drainage, street lighting, and pedestrian facilities.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. In this area, funding priorities set by Chugiak, Birchwood, Eagle River Rural Road Service Area Board.

Eagle River Area Snow Disposal Site

Problem: CBERRRSA needs additional snow storage capacity.

Scope: This project will construct a snow disposal facility serving the Chugiak, Birchwood, Eagle River Rural Road Service Area (CBERRRSA).

Status: No work is underway, However, a 2008 state grant has been requested for site selection, acquisition, and preliminary engineering funding.

Eagle River Chugiak Road and Drainage System Rehab

Problem: Road and drainage needs existing throughout the service area.

Scope: Construct road and drainage improvements.

Status: The Chugiak, Birchwood, Eagle River Rural Road Service Area Board manages funding collected through property taxes for road and drainage improvements in their area. The local road board evaluates and prioritizes projects for funding. In addition, state grant funding is pursued annually.

Ravenwood Elementary Pedestrian Safety

Problem: Students who live in Eaglewood subdivision often walk across Eagle River Lane and the Ptarmigan Boulevard intersection.

Scope: Construct a safe crosswalk, move the existing trail further from the road, and add a barrier to prevent students from taking a hazardous route across this intersection.

Status: This project has been funded with school and community council coordination underway. 2008 construction is planned

Eagle River Ln Pedestrian Improvements

Problem: Existing pedestrian facilities are inadequate.

Scope: Expand pedestrian facilities.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska.

STATE OF ALASKA

Eagle River Loop Rd Reconstruction - Old Glenn Hwy to Eagle River Rd

Problem: The road is not constructed to collector standards.

Scope: Collector improvements typically include a new road base, pavement, curbs, underground drainage, street lights, and pedestrian facilities. Shoulders and turn lanes will be included.

Status: Design is substantially completed and construction by the State of Alaska is expected to start in 2008. This is a state owned facility.

Eagle River Rd Rehabilitation - MP 5.3 to MP 12.6

Problem: Pavement on this collector road is deteriorating.

Scope: This project will rehabilitate Eagle River Rd from Milepost 5.3 to 12.6 by widening the shoulders for pedestrians, improve visibility for drivers, and repave the road.

Status: Design efforts are underway on this state owned facility. Construction is tentatively scheduled for 2009 or 2010, subject to funding availability. ROW approval & acquisition is also required.

Eagle River Rd Trail Rehab - Old Glenn Hwy to Mile Hi Rd

Problem: The existing trail is showing its age and is no longer cost effective to maintain.

Scope: This project will rehabilitate the Eagle River Road Trail from the Old Glenn Highway to Mile Hi Road.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state route and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska.

Eagle River Rd Upgrade - Old Glenn Hwy to Greenhouse Rd (MP5.3ish)

Problem: Future vehicle and pedestrian traffic may require the expansion of this facility.

Scope: Not set.

Status: No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska.
