The local road board evaluates and prioritizes projects for funding. In addition, state grant funding is pursued annually. Farm Ave/End St Sidewalks Problem: Interest has been expressed in adding sidewalks to these local roads. Scope: Install sidewalks. This project is a priority for local property owners, the State of Alaska, Maintenance staff, elected officials, and the Community Council. This project will improve drainage along the Glenn Highway and Eagle Glen Subdivision Area. Scope: Specific improvements will be identified in the design study. Design funding has been provided from the Flooding and Glaciation Matching fund program. Status: Negotiations were completed with Kinney Engineering for design study work.
