Seward Hwy Lane Expansion - Potter Weigh Station to Southern AMATS boundary	
Problem:	Increasing traffic is expected to exceed the capacity of the existing facility.
Scope:	The scope has not been set, by may include additional lanes.
Status:	No work is underway. This is a state-owned facility and evaluation and funding would be by the State of Alaska. The route is identified as a major arterial in the Official Streets and Highways Plan.
Soward Hwy Poad/Bridge Pohah - MP 75 to 90	

Seward Hwy Road/Bridge Rehab - MP 75 to 90

Problem: Bridges are deteriorating.

Scope: Rehabilitate pavement and rehabilitate or replace the following bridges: Placer Creek, Portage Creek, 20 Mile River, Peterson Creek, Virgin Creek, and Glacier Creek. Project may include road realignment, grade separations at Portage Valley and the Alyeska Hwy, passing lanes,

and pedestrian accommodations.

Status: No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state-owned facility and evaluation and funding would be through the State of Alaska. The State is conducting some preliminary scoping along with preliminary engineering.
