Whitney Dr Upgrade - North C St to Post Rd

Problem: The road was recently resurfaced, but is not constructed to collector standards.**Scope:** While the scope is not set, urban collector standards typically include a new road base, curbs, pavement, storm drains, pedestrian facilities, and street lighting.**Status:** No work is underway and no funding is proposed in the approved CIP. The project will remain on the Capital Projects Needs List for future funding consideration. The route is designated as a collector in the Official Streets and Highways Plan (OS&HP).**STATE OF ALASKA**

C St/Oceandock Rd Access Ramp Reconstruction

Problem: The pavement is deteriorating on this ramp at the north end of the A/C Street bridge over Ship Creek**Scope:** Replace or overlay pavement.**Status:** No work is underway or funding scheduled. This is a state-owned route and evaluation and funding would be by the State of Alaska DOT..

Ingra St/Gambell St Extension - 3rd Ave to Whitney Rd

Problem: The connection will be a critical transportation connection to minimize traffic impacts on downtown, if the Knik Arm Crossing moves forward.**Scope:** Construct major transportation corridor.**Status:** No work is underway or funding scheduled. This is a state-owned route and evaluation and funding would be by the State of Alaska DOT.
