STATE OF ALASKA

Seward Hwy Lane Expansion - Potter Weigh Station to Southern AMATS boundary

Problem: Increasing traffic is expected to exceed the capacity of the existing facility.

Scope: The scope has not been set, but may include additional lanes.

Status: No work is underway. This is a state-owned facility and evaluation and funding would be by the State of Alaska. The route is identified as a major arterial in the Official Streets and Highways Plan (OS&HP).

Seward Hwy Road/Bridge Rehab - MP 75 to 90

Problem: Bridges are deteriorating.

Scope: Rehabilitate pavement and rehabilitate or replace the following bridges: Placer Creek, Portage Creek, 20 Mile River, Peterson Creek, Virgin Creek, and Glacier Creek. Project may include road realignment, grade separations at Portage Valley and the Alyeska

Status: The State is conducting some preliminary scoping along with preliminary engineering. No work is underway or funding scheduled. Construction is anticipated in 2013.
